Section 1 HTML5 VPN Portal

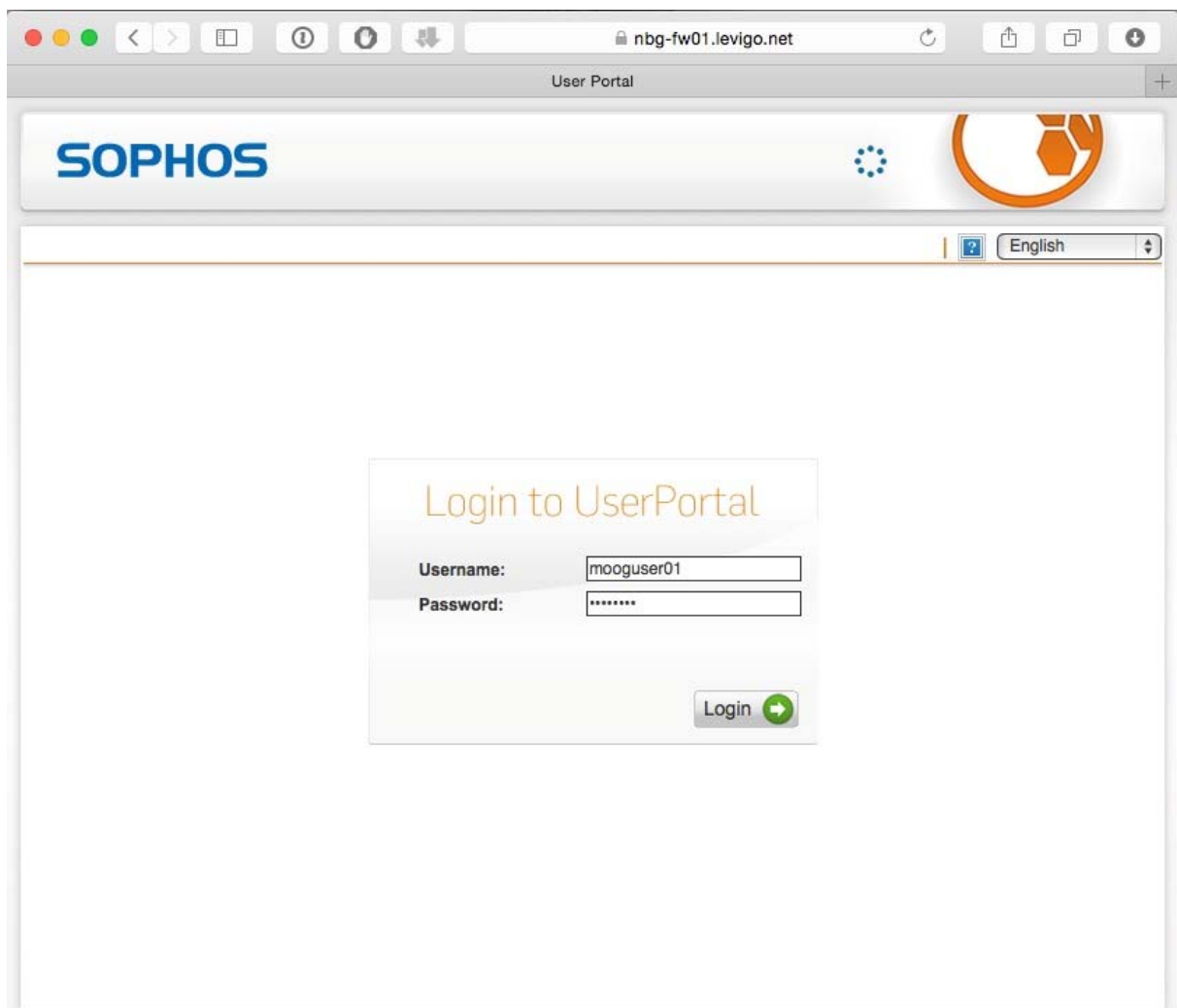
Requirements

To use the Virtual-Desktops we need:

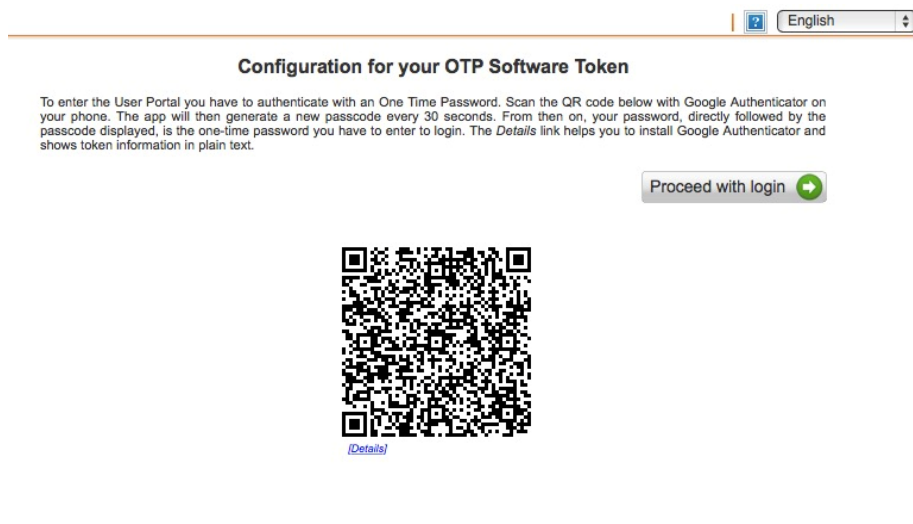
- Mobilephone Android/iOS/BB
- App: Google Authenticator
- Computer with Internet

Steps

1. open the link in a browser (Firefox / Chrome work best – IE sometimes has problems)

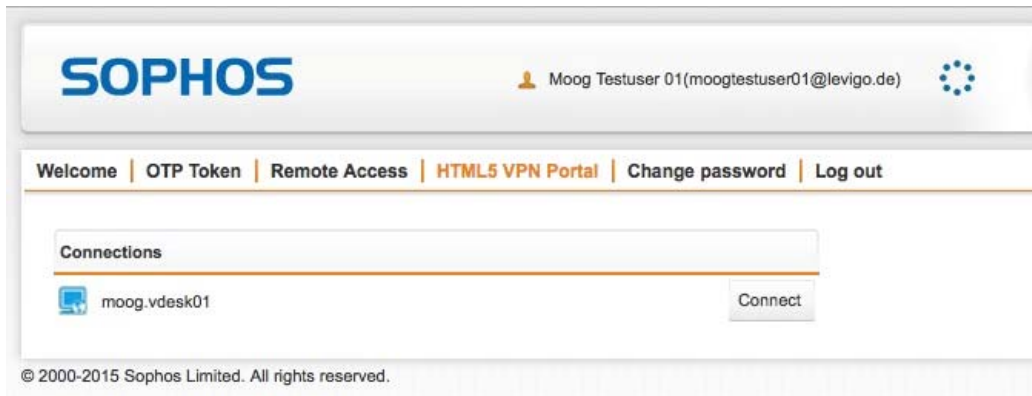


2. During the first login the given password is required – after authenticating, the setup page for Google Authenticator (GA) is being displayed (see screenshot below). Create and entry by scanning the QR code below within Google Authenticator on your phone. The app will then generate a new passcode every 30 seconds. Once you click the “Proceed with login” button you will see the login prompt once again – this happens only during initial login. Enter username and fixed piece of the password, directly followed by the passcode displayed in Google Authenticator. The Details link helps you to install Google Authenticator and shows token information in plain text.



3. Now we can login with the Credentials:
 - a. Username: mooguser01
 - b. Password: passwordTOKENID (example: „plaw0rd239548“)
4. Once you have successfully logged into the portal you have several options (see below)
 - a. OTP Token, gives you the barcode again to setup the Google Authenticator app
 - b. Remote access – provides links to download the VPN client
 - c. HTML 5 VPN Portal – provides a link to the Webversion of the access to the virtual desktop
 - d. Change password – here you can change the fixed part of the password
 - e. Logout – logout here once you finished your vdesk session

5. Open Tab „HTML5 VPN Portal“ and click „Connect“ – then you will be prompted for the credentials to login to the vdesk.



Once logged on to the desktop you will find your applications to connect to the resources that you need within the Moog network – note: the access to the Moog network is dependent on the access that has been requested / granted – please contact your Moog contact if you have questions regarding this. Section 2 VPN client - Remote Access VPN

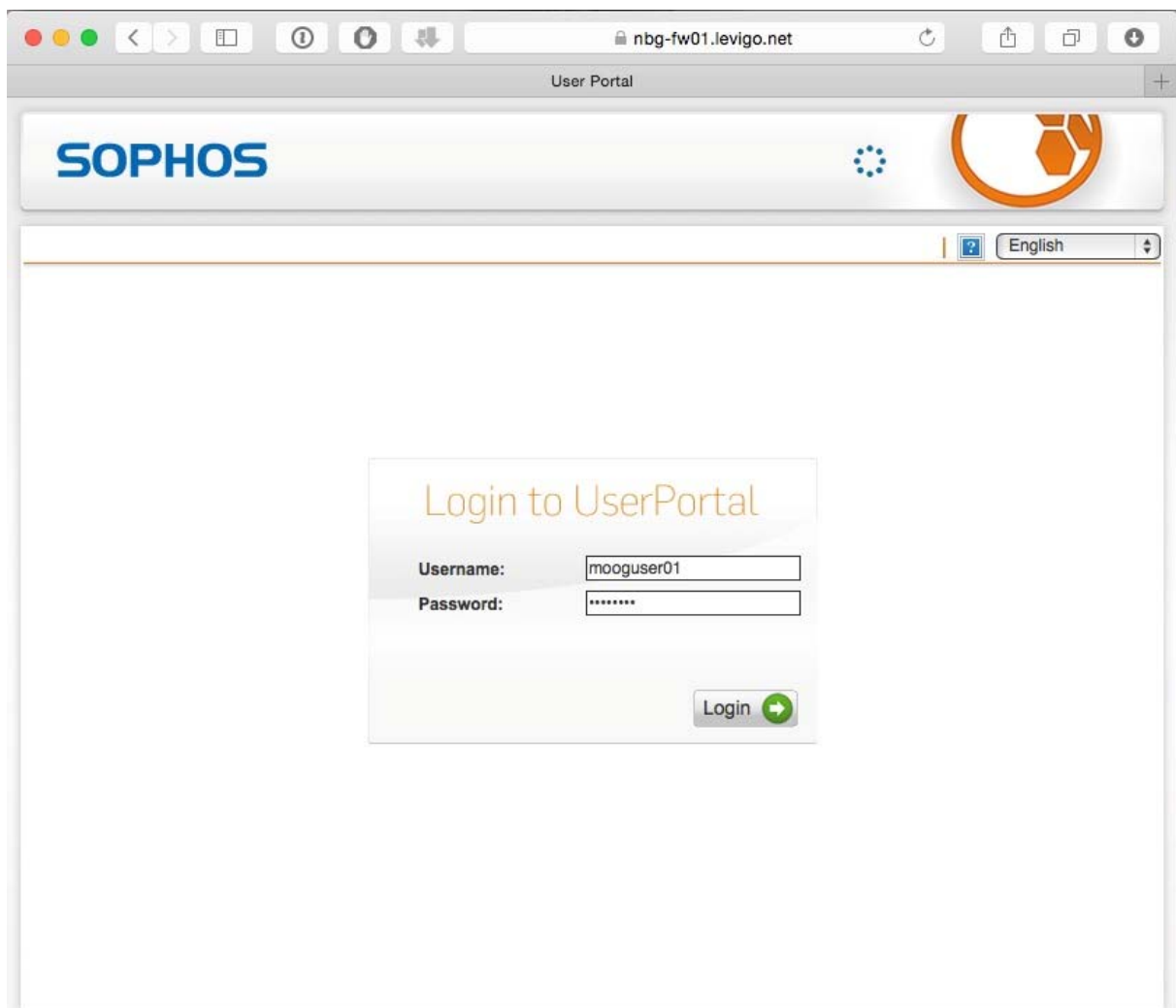
Requirements

To use the Virtual-Desktops we need:

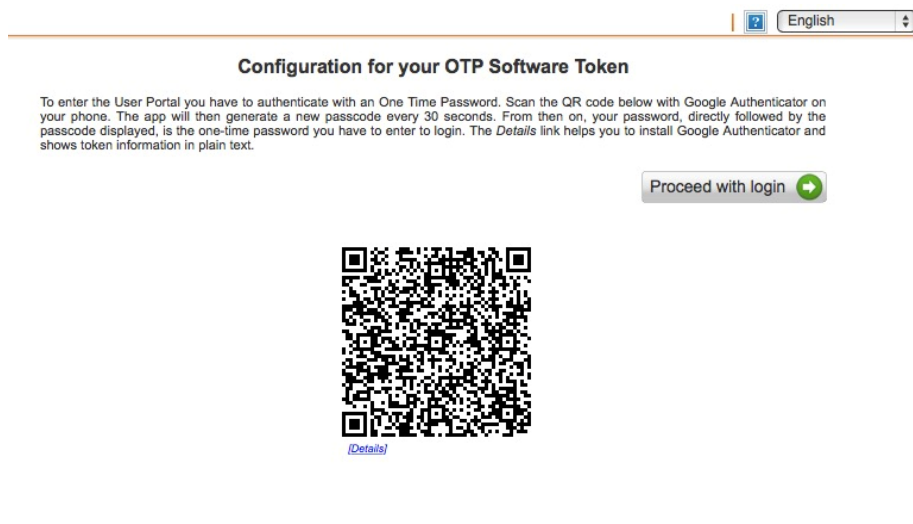
- Windows PC / Linux / OSX (Tunnelblick)
- Mobile-App: Google Authenticator
- Internet

Steps

1. open the link in a browser (Firefox / Chrome work best – IE sometimes has problems)

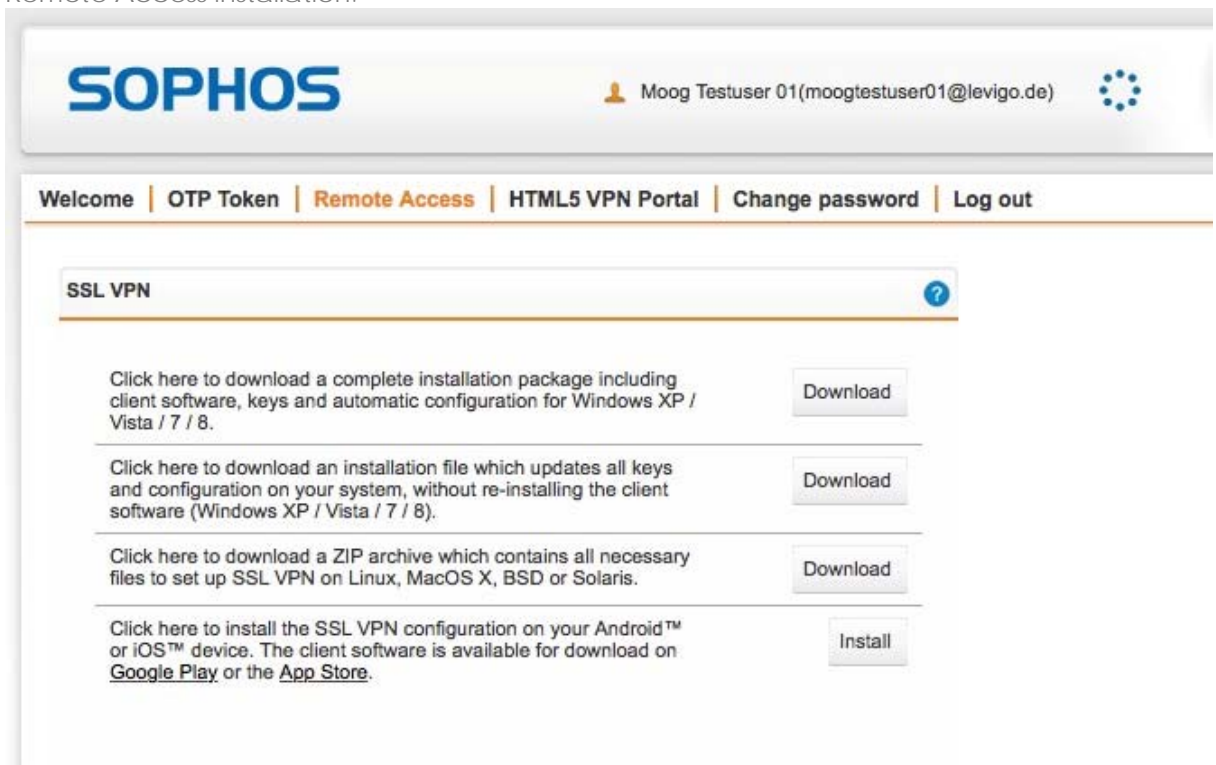


2. During the first login the given password is required – after authenticating, the setup page for Google Authenticator (GA) is being displayed (see screenshot below). Create and entry by scanning the QR code below within Google Authenticator on your phone. The app will then generate a new passcode every 30 seconds. Once you click the “Proceed with login” button you will see the login prompt once again – this happens only during initial login. Enter username and fixed piece of the password, directly followed by the passcode displayed in Google Authenticator. The Details link helps you to install Google Authenticator and shows token information in plain text.



3. Now we can login with the Credentials:
 - a. Username: mooguser01
 - b. Password: passwordTOKENID (example: „plaw0rd239548“)

4. Open Tab „Remote Access“ and click „Download (on the top)“ for a new Windows Remote Access installation.



5. After download and install the software „double-click“ on traffic light to connect.



6. Enter username and password (fixed part and variable part from GA)
7. Once the VPN connection was established successfully you can connect with remote desktop (mstsc) to the destination machine. Login with the credentials provided for this – these are other credentials that have been used for the VPN login.
8. Once logged on to the desktop you will find your applications to connect to the resources that you need within the Moog network – note: the access to the Moog network is dependent on the access that has been requested / granted – please contact your Moog contact if you have questions regarding this.
